

**Application to record an overseas birth in the register of births (section 36 of the Civil Status Act)**

The birth should be registered at the registry office in whose district the child, or the applicant if the child has never lived in Germany, is resident, or was last resident in Germany, or is habitually resident. A minor child is deemed to have the same residence as the parent(s) holding parental responsibility.  
 Registry Office I in Berlin is only responsible if neither the child nor the applicant has ever been resident in Germany at any stage of their lives.

The fee charged by Registry Office I in Berlin for processing applications to enter an overseas birth in the register of births is 60 euros (irrespective of outcome). An additional 20 euros must be paid if foreign law is involved. The current charge for a birth certificate is **10 euros**, for each additional copy of the same certificate ordered at the same time a fee of **5 euros** will be charged. **The fees charged by other German registry offices may differ.**

A separate invoice for the fees will be issued by the competent German registry office. Please wait until you receive this invoice before transferring any money. Do not pay in advance!
